On behalf of the Humboldt County Board of Supervisors, I am writing in support of the proposed Trinidad Harbor ASBS Storm Water Discharge Elimination and Management Project. The Board recognizes this as an important opportunity to eliminate and manage storm water discharges into the Trinidad Head Area of Special Biological Significance (ASBS).

Implementation of the Trinidad Harbor ASBS Storm Water Discharge Elimination and Management Project, Trinidad Rancheria's SWRCB Proposition 1 storm water grant project, will provide a long term solution that will improve water quality and address the non-point source pollution associated with the Trinidad Harbor Pier parking lot runoff that discharges to Trinidad Head ASBS. Improving the quality of waters entering the Trinidad Head ASBS is the driving force behind this integrated watershed planning process. The project will protect and enhance the natural qualities of aquatic resources and to preserve the area's available marine, wetland, and riparian habitats.

The Trinidad Harbor ASBS Storm Water Discharge Elimination and Management Project will address, reduce and eliminate the prohibited non-point source pollution and sedimentation associated with the Trinidad Harbor Pier Parking Lot runoff that discharges to Trinidad Bay, by reducing runoff volumes, decreasing elevated suspended solids (TSS), converting impervious surfaces to pervious surfaces and capturing storm water runoff in cisterns and rain gardens.

We respectfully encourage both the State and Regional Water Quality Control Boards to support this important project for the protection and enhancement of a valuable marine resource in the Trinidad Head ASBS.
