

WHEREAS, the Elders Dinner will be served from Noon to 3:00 p.m. (or when all food has been served) and will feature the traditional Salmon cooked over an alder wood fire as well as a full turkey dinner; and

WHEREAS, there will be a special honoring and gifting of all Elders in attendance; and

WHEREAS, demonstrations of traditional California and other Tribal dances will be performed throughout the day.
