County of Humboldt as the certificate holder, with the amount of said coverage a minimum of One Million

Dollars (\$1,000,000) per occurrence.

- (8) The TENANT agrees to indemnify and hold harmless and, at its own risk, cost, and expense, defend the COUNTY, its Board of Supervisors, officers, agents, employees, and volunteers from and against any and all liability expense, including defense costs. Legal fees and claims for damages arising from TENANT negligence, intentional acts, or breaches of this Agreement. Indemnification with respect to defense costs shall be made at the time COUNTY incur such costs.
- (9) Should the TENANT fail to deliver the certificates/policy of insurance as specified in paragraph 6, this Rental Agreement shall terminate immediately.
- (10) The TENANT shall vacate the premises and surrender to the COUNTY in the event the COUNTY, at its sole discretion, requires the premises for emergency use.
