## 52<sup>nd</sup> Annual California Native American Day

**WHEREAS**, to celebrate and honor the historic and cultural contributions of California Native Americans, the 52<sup>nd</sup> Annual California Native American Day will take place on the west steps of the California State Capitol on September 27, 2019 from 10 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.; and

**WHEREAS**, Native American Day began in California in 1939 when Governor Culbert Olson dedicated October 1<sup>st</sup> as “Indian Day”; and

**WHEREAS**, in 1968, California Tribal Leaders and Governor Ronald Reagan declared the fourth Friday of September as “California Indian Day”; and

**WHEREAS**, the Native American Day Celebration has become a time-honored tradition in the Native American community.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that Humboldt County Board of Supervisors hereby honors all Native American people and proclaims September 27, 2019 Native American Day in Humboldt County.
