**AUTHORITY:** Humboldt County Resolution No. 10-01

**APPOINTING POWER:** Board of Supervisors

**MEMBERS:** 7 members total:  
5 appointed by each District Supervisor  
1 appointed by the Humboldt County Sheriff  
1 shall be the President of the Humboldt Deputy Sheriff's Organization or his/her designee

**QUALIFICATIONS:** Resident of Humboldt County.

**TERM:** Supervisor's appointees serve a 4-year term to run concurrent with the term of office for each Supervisor.  
Sheriff's appointee serves a 4-year term to run concurrent with the term of office for the Sheriff.  
HDSO President's appointee shall serve four years from the date of appointment.

**FUNCTION:** Help educate the public on law enforcement policies and procedures of the County Sheriff's Office.
