These amendments to the Local Coastal Program (LCP) update local regulations to prohibit all Industrial Hemp Activities. The ordinance amendments are part of ongoing efforts to regulate land uses associated with commercial cannabis in the county. The proposed ordinance would apply within the unincorporated areas of Humboldt County in the Coastal Zone.

The Ordinance would add Section 313-55.5 et seq. of Title III, Division I, Chapter 3, Section B, Part 1 (Coastal Zoning Regulations), of the Humboldt County Code.
