POST-ADOPTION SUMMARY OF ORDINANCE ____-____ AMENDING THE ZONING REGULATIONS; AMENDING SECTIONS 314-55.4.8.2 AND 314-55.4.10.3 OF CHAPTER 4 OF DIVISION 1 OF TITLE III OF THE HUMBOLDT COUNTY CODE.

On Tuesday, November 18, 2025, during its regularly scheduled meeting, the Humboldt County Board of Supervisors adopted Ordinance _____ which amends the Planning Code related to cannabis microbusinesses and manufacturing. The Ordinance amends the Commercial Cultivation, Processing, Manufacturing, Distribution, Testing, and Sale of Cannabis Land Use regulations, such that they allow microbusinesses to be permitted as Zoning Clearance Certificates when all associated uses are also permissible via Zoning Clearance Certificate and such that they allow nonvolatile manufacturing activities to be permitted with a Zoning Clearance Certificate when in association with a cultivation permit, provided they meet certain requirements. This ordinance amends Section 314-55 of Chapter 4 of Division 1 of Title III of the Humboldt County Code. The ordinance will become effective thirty (30) days after the date of adoption.
