RECOMMENDATION(S):


That the Board of Supervisors:

2. Authorize the Chair of the Board to execute the project agreement upon submittal of the appropriate bonds and insurance.
3. Direct the Auditor-Controller to establish a new contract account 1200321-0333 and transfer \$421,568.00 from 1200321-2118 to the new contract account per the attached appropriation transfer.

DISCUSSION:

On June 5, 2018, the Board of Supervisors authorized the Clerk of the Board to advertise the above-referenced project for bids. On June 26, 2018, the county received eight (8) bids for the project. The results are as follows:

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

This project is being funded by FEMA Disaster funds. FEMA will cover 75 percent of the project costs, Cal OES will cover 75 percent of the remaining 25 percent of project costs, and the Road Fund will cover the remaining 6.25 percent of costs. Construction costs were included in the Fiscal Year 2018-19 Road Fund Budget. This item has no impact on the General Fund.

This project conforms to the Board of Supervisors' Core Role of providing for and maintaining infrastructure as identified in the Board's Strategic Framework.

ALTERNATIVES TO STAFF RECOMMENDATIONS:

The Board may choose not to award the contract; however, staff does not recommend this alternative because this project will replace the failed culvert using funds that would not otherwise be available to the county.
