SECTION 1. Section 224-2 of Chapter 4 of Division 2 of Title  
II of the Humboldt County Code is hereby amended to read as shown

SECTION 2. Section 224-5 of Chapter 4 of Division 2 of Title  
II of the Humboldt County Code is hereby amended to read as shown  
on the attached page 36.1.


SECTION 3. This ordinance shall become effective thirty (30)

## CHAPTER 4

HUMBOLDT COUNTY FISH AND GAME ADVISORY COMMITTEE

## 224-1. ESTABLISHMENT OF COMMITTEE.

The Fish and Game Advisory Committee of the County of Humboldt is hereby established. (Ord. 682 § 1, 7/8/69)

## 224-2. APPOINTMENT OF MEMBERS OF COMMITTEE.

The Committee shall consist of fifteen (15) members. The Board of Supervisors, by majority vote, shall appoint five (5) members at large, and the Supervisor of each district shall appoint two (2) members. The two (2) members appointed by the individual Supervisors of Districts 1, 2 and 3 shall serve a term which shall become effective on the date the member is appointed and shall expire on June 30, 1985. The two (2) members appointed by the individual Supervisors of Districts 4 and 5 shall serve a term which shall become effective on the date the member is appointed and shall expire on June 30, 1987. Three (3) of the members appointed by a majority of the Board shall serve a term which shall become effective on the date the member is appointed and shall expire on June 30, 1986; and two (2) of the members appointed by a majority of the Board shall serve a term which shall become effective on the date the member is appointed and shall expire on June 30, 1988. All subsequent appointments to fill vacancies which result from the expiration of a term of office shall be for a term of four (4) years from and after the expiration of the term of the office to which the appointment is being made. Persons appointed to fill a vacancy which results from an event other than expiration of a term of office shall serve until expiration of the term of the office to which the appointment is made. Members of the Committee shall serve at the pleasure of the Board of Supervisors. (Ord. 1444 § 2, 1/13/81; amended by Ord. 1660 § 1, 10/30/84)

## 224-3. PURPOSE OF COMMITTEE.

The Committee is established to serve in an advisory capacity to the Board of Supervisors in all matters concerning fish and game within the County of Humboldt. (Ord. 682 § 3, 7/8/69)

## 224-4. MEETINGS.

The Committee shall hold regular monthly meetings at such time and place as shall be agreed upon by the Committee and such other special meetings as shall be required from time to time. Special meetings may be called by the Chairman of the Committee or, in his absence, by the Vice Chairman of the Committee. (Ord. 682 § 4, 7/8/69)

§ 224-5. REMOVAL OF MEMBERS FOR FAILURE TO ATTEND MEETINGS.

In the event that any member of the Committee shall absent himself from three (3) consecutive regular meetings of the Committee without showing good cause therefor to the Chairman, at the fourth such consecutive regular meeting from which he is absent his place shall automatically become vacant. Such vacancy shall be reported to the Board of Supervisors, and another member shall be appointed by the original appointing power and the person so appointed shall serve for the unexpired term of the member whose absence gave rise to the vacancy.
