Subject:

Local Transportation Fund Additional Claim for Fiscal Year 2015-16

RECOMMENDATION(S): That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1. Approves the attached Annual Project and Financial Plan representing the Local Transportation Fund additional claim for FY 2015-16; and
- 2. Directs the Public Works Department to submit the Annual Project and Financial Plan to the Humboldt County Association of Governments (HCAOG).

<u>SOURCE OF FUNDING</u>: Transportation Services (1150910) – Local Transportation Fund (LTF) and Fund 1150 – General Expense Transportation Services

<u>DISCUSSION</u>: On January 19, 2016, the Board approved the LTF partial claim that included this fiscal year's allocations for the following: Redwood Transit System, Southern Humboldt Service, Arcata/McKinleyville Dial-A-Ride/Lift, Adult Day Health Care-Mad River, Humboldt Senior Resource Center, Willow Creek Extension Route, Transit Set Aside, Klamath-Trinity Non-Emergency Transportation and Bicycle & Trailways. The allocation for Eureka Transit Service (ETS) & Dial-A-Ride was held in reserve pending ETS' submittal of claim information while the Reserve for Unmet Transit Needs would be determined after ETS' allocation was met. ETS has submitted its budget claim information and the Public Works Department is submitting the additional claim for the Reserve for Unmet Transit Needs share to Fund 1150 to complete the County's FY 2015-16 LTF allocation.

The Annual Project and Financial Plan being submitted includes the allocation for ETS and Reserve for Unmet Transit Needs for FY 2015-16.
