The Humboldt County Board of Supervisors supports the Mattole Salmon Group's funding request to the California State Coastal Conservancy for their fisheries restoration project in the estuary area of the Mattole River. This project will place 100 whole trees in the river for fish habitat, plant thousands of riparian trees and cuttings, and finalize analysis and designs to reconnect significant off-channel slough habitat.....all within the First District.

This project is designed to create immediate improvements in fish habitat assisting these endangered salmonid species deal with drought and other impacts. The project is a part of a larger 5 Year Estuary Restoration Plan developed by BLM and their partners.

Partners in this project include the Bureau of Land Management, US Fish and Wildlife Service, NOAA, The Nature Conservancy, the National Fish and Wildlife Foundation, CA Department of Water Resources, and the CA Department of Fish and Wildlife, local landowners, and the Mattole Restoration Council, and the State Coastal Conservancy.

The Mattole Salmon Group, the Mattole Restoration Council and many local, regional, state, and federal partners have been working for three decades to restore salmon habitat in the Mattole. These efforts are beginning to pay off as headwaters streams clear quicker after a storm and as significant instream habitat in the headwaters and estuary areas gets restored.

This project, with support from the State Coastal Conservancy, will help to leverage needed funds to piece together this next phase of restoration in the Mattole.

Our Board strongly supports the efforts of the Mattole Salmon Group and their partners and respectfully requests your approval of this very important funding request.
