On Tuesday, September 21, 2021, during its regularly scheduled Board meeting, the Humboldt County Board of Supervisors adopted Ordinance amending Section 314-55.3 of Chapter 4 of Division 1 of Title III of the Humboldt County Code to require that an application for two (2) Retirement, Remediation and Relocation (RRR) proposing relocation on properties on a single receiving site is required to apply for a discretionary special permit and to eliminate the enhanced setback requirements for cannabis distribution and testing and research facilities within the unincorporated area of the County of Humboldt.
