



# Citizen Research and Monitoring

Gaps in biological and water quality monitoring limit the ability to understand why water temperatures and turbidity are too high, and fish populations are too low. The Citizen Research and Monitoring Program collects scientifically based biological and water quality monitoring data to better understand environmental issues in the Mad River. Partnering with local, state, and federal agencies the Alliance is working to fill information gaps and use that knowledge to protect and restore the Mad River watershed.
