WHEREAS, Mike Campbell will be retiring on November 2, 2021, after 20 years of employment service to the California Highway Patrol – Humboldt Area Office; and

WHEREAS, Mike was first hired in August 2000, as a CHP Cadet and attended the CHP Academy in West Sacramento, and later promoted CHP Officer in February 2001; and

WHEREAS, Officer Campbell was assigned to the Hayward CHP Area in 2001, where he was assigned to road patrol duties in support of the CHP's mission of saving lives; and

WHEREAS, Officer Campbell transferred to the Garberville CHP Area in January 2003, and

WHEREAS, Officer Campbell transferred to the Humboldt CHP Area in January 2006; where he was selected to become a Field Training Officer to help train and mentor the next generation of CHP officers; and

WHEREAS, Officer Campbell worked diligently to reduce the occurrence of auto theft in the region and was recognized for his efforts by receiving a Master 10851 Award from the American Automobile Association, and

WHEREAS, Officer Campbell promoted to the rank of Sergeant in May 2015, where he was assigned to the Willow Creek Resident Post; and

WHEREAS, Sergeant Campbell received a Commander's Commendation for his work to help reduce the trafficking of illicit drugs in the region, where his direct efforts were recognized on an asset forfeiture case yielding over \$100,000 in seized drug monies, and

WHEREAS, Sergeant Campbell was instrumental in providing leadership and support during a critical incident in which a CHP officer was gravely wounded, and

WHEREAS, Sergeant Campbell served as the Crescent City Acting Commander, and worked diligently to help with managing the day-to-day operations of the Crescent City Area; and

WHEREAS, Sergeant Campbell has received a Division Commanders Commendation for his sustained exemplary performance as the senior sergeant and administrative sergeant for the Humboldt CHP Area; and

WHEREAS, Sergeant Campbell has been instrumental in his role as the senior sergeant and administrative sergeant for the California Highway Patrol Humboldt Area. He is known for his dedication and enthusiasm to his job. He was highly competent in his assignment by which he received high praise from his peers and superiors alike for his work ethic and professionalism.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Humboldt County Board of Supervisors, Captain Shawn Morris, and the staff of the Humboldt CHP Area hereby commend Sergeant Mike Campbell for his 20 years of service, and together, wish him success in his retirement.
