RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF A PORTION OF BENBOW DRIVE
FOR THE 20TH ANNUAL 4TH OF JULY FIREWORKS DISPLAY ON JULY 4, 2026

WHEREAS, the Southern Humboldt Chamber of Commerce has been informed by the California Department of Transportation that Humboldt County Board of Supervisors must pass a resolution authorizing the closure of Benbow Drive on July 4, 2026; and

WHEREAS, the Southern Humboldt Chamber of Commerce is planning the 20th Annual 4th of July Fireworks Display on that day between the hour of dusk (approximately 9:30 p.m. and 10:30 p.m.); and


WHEREAS, the east turn lane of the southbound Benbow Highway 101 off-ramp will be closed during the fireworks display; and

WHEREAS, California Department of Transportation will provide cones to block traffic at the various intersections.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Humboldt County Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the closure of a portion of Benbow Drive in Garberville, California during the hour of dusk and 10:30 p.m. on July 4, 2026 in order to allow the Southern Humboldt Chamber of Commerce to conduct the 20th Annual 4th of July Fireworks Display.
