On Tuesday, August 19, 2025, during its regularly scheduled meeting, the Humboldt County Board of Supervisors adopted Ordinance which adopts the Inland	
Outdoor Lighting Ordinance. The Inland Outdoor Lighting Ordinance establishes design guidelines for outdoor lighting to protect unincorporated Humboldt County from light pollution and light trespass. This ordinance adds section 314-105.1 and amends sections 314-138, 314-141, 314-142, 314-147, and 314-154 of Chapter 4 of Division 1 of Title III of the Humboldt County Code.
