for tires and rims that were available at the time of purchase, about 15 years ago. Tires and wheel assemblies have since changed to the point that this machine is no longer suited to the task of mounting and dismounting tires on newer vehicles without risking injury to the operator or damage to the tire or rim assembly. The Hoffman MSC8600 will address all these issues and has on-site product support. Fleet Services mounts and dismounts approximately 750 tires per year.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

The estimated cost for the tire changer is approximately \$16,000. There are sufficient savings from the roof replacement to cover the cost of the new tire changer. The attached budget transfer moves the funds to the appropriate fixed asset line.

The purchase of this machine supports the Board's Strategic Framework by managing resources to ensure the sustainability of services that county departments provide to the public by providing safe, dependable transportation.

ALTERNATIVES TO STAFF RECOMMENDATIONS:

The purchase could be denied but is not recommended due to the number of tires that would need to be sent to outside vendors for mounting.
