Attached for the Planning Commission's record and review is the following supplementary information:

To the Humboldt County Zoning Administrator,

I am writing to you anonymously today, in regard to a commercial cannabis cultivation request in the Miranda area, for Rick Cooper, Humboldt Sanctuary PLN-12990-CUP on APN 221-071-020 for 28,500 square feet of outdoor commercial cannabis cultivation.

I have a number of concerns regarding this request. Rick Cooper has a history of sexual predation in our community. I personally know many people with whom he invited to his home as underaged teenagers, whom he drugged and committed sexual acts upon. He frequently invited dozens of teenagers to his home for huge parties involving alcohol. These violent acts were premeditated, and meticulously planned out. He has also molested children. The list of victims is extensive, and it has been very traumatic for our community. Unfortunately, the statute of limitations prevents any justice from occurring.

I personally was invited to his home as an underaged teenager, with my partner at the time. He drugged me, rendering me unconscious, and attempted to perform sexual acts upon me.

If Mr Cooper is unable to control himself in such predatory ways, he cannot be trusted to maintain the law and environmental regulations regarding this permit.

Mr Cooper also has a history of bringing very questionable people to his property, as well as a history of hiring people who would work all season for him, whom he would then refuse to pay for their work.

Approval of this permit only invites questionable people to our neighborhood, and possibly invites more people to be preyed upon.

Frankly, our neighborhood feels less safe with him here.
