PROJECT OVERVIEW

1. Establish a Humboldt County Human Trafficking Community Coalition identifying existing resources and creates needed resources for sexually trafficked and exploited individuals within Humboldt County.
2. Identify and create a Humboldt County Human Trafficking Resource Database.
3. Make HCHT Resource Database accessible to identified wrap-around service providers including but not limited to law enforcement, non-profit, faith-based organizations, social services [i.e. Humboldt Rape Crisis, Humboldt Domestic Violence, Youth Service Bureau, Raven Project, Landing Pad, etc.]

TIMELINE

OUTCOMES

1. Current resources identified and organized into a database available for identified wrap-around service providers including but not limited to law enforcement, non-profit, faith-based organizations, social services [i.e. Humboldt Rape Crisis, Humboldt Domestic Violence, Youth Service Bureau, Raven Project, Landing Pad, etc.]

THOSE BENEFITTED

1. Humboldt County sexually trafficked and exploited individuals, law enforcement, community service providers and residents. Over 100,000 benefitted.
2. Sexually trafficked individuals currently unidentified and underreported will have a baseline to establish resources and statistics.

EXISTING RESOURCES

The purpose of the database is to identify local expertise, leadership and volunteers throughout Humboldt County to strengthen the collaborate support of identified individuals.
