The Humboldt County Board of Supervisors is pleased to submit this letter of support for the Trinidad Rancheria's Transportation Investment Generating Economic Recovery (TIGER) grant application for the stabilization of Cher-Ae Lane and other associated safety improvements. This project will address several of the unmet transportation and economic needs of the Trinidad Rancheria, the local community and the Region. This project will provide safe and sustainable access, for all modes of transportation, to/from the Trinidad Rancheria. It will both modernize infrastructure and revitalize the residents and businesses located on the Trinidad Rancheria leading to improved socio-economic conditions.

The key benefits and objectives as we understand this project are:

- Safety: Directly addresses safety for most vulnerable transportation users (pedestrians, bicyclists, children) and will stabilize Cher-Ae Lane making it usable by emergency vehicles, school buses, transit buses, elders and community members whom reside on the Rancheria, community members seeking services, employees of the Rancheria and visitors
- **Significance:** The Trinidad Rancheria is the largest employer in the Trinidad area and the largest share of their work force is located within the Rancheria property (accessed only by Cher-Ae Lane). If this route were to become inaccessible, it would be catastrophic to the local economy
- Economic Activity: Servicing the Economically Distressed Area of the Trinidad
 Community by creating and enhancing construction activity and increasing economic
 opportunity while furthering the efforts of the Trinidad Rancheria to be self sufficient
- **Readiness:** Strategically developed to accelerate implementation (no ROW acq., minimal permitting) by the September 30, 2019 obligation deadline

 Leveraging: Builds on previous joint partnership in Rancheria conceptual master planning and furthers several priority capital improvement projects identified in the Trinidad Rancheria Transportation Plan

The Project will improve upon and build from the joint inter-agency cooperation (California Department of Transportation, Humboldt County Association of Governments, County of Humboldt and Tribal) that created the Trinidad Rancheria Comprehensive Plan and Integrated Development Standards.

This project will address several of the unmet transportation and economic needs of the Trinidad Rancheria, the local community and the Region. This project will both modernize infrastructure and revitalize the residents and businesses located on the Trinidad Rancheria leading to improved socio-economic conditions locally and increase benefits to goods-movement throughout our region while contributing towards expanded statewide efforts.

The key benefits and objectives as we understand this project are:

- Safety: Directly addresses safety for most vulnerable transportation users (pedestrians, bicyclists, children) and will stabilize Cher-Ae Lane making it usable by emergency vehicles, school buses, transit buses, employees of the Rancheria and visitors
- Significance: Provides multi-state benefit by improving nationally-significant highway; and will provide local benefit by reduction of traffic on Scenic Drive reducing maintenance costs to both City of Trinidad and County of Humboldt. Scenic Drive is subject to regular storm damage due to the geology of the area the road is constructed over and a new interchange and access is extremely important to the residents on Scenic Drive in order to ensure access at times when Scenic Drive is closed due to storm damage
- Economic Activity: Servicing the Economically Distressed Area of the Trinidad
 Community by creating and enhancing construction activity and increasing economic
 opportunity by "destination place-making" while furthering the efforts of the Trinidad
 Rancheria to be self sufficient

- Livability: Increases community identity and cultural character as unique destination
 gateway, and removes a barrier for residents, employees and visitors by affording an
 opportunity for public transit directly to the Rancheria rather than using personal
 vehicles or having to walk a mile along a narrow roadway with no pedestrian amenities
- Travel Choices: Transforms pass-through highway into context-sensitive corridor and provides an alternate route for people who live on or south of the Rancheria during road closures
- Readiness: Strategically developed to accelerate implementation (no ROW acq., minimal permitting) by the September 2016 TIGER obligation deadline
- Leveraging: Builds on previous joint partnership in Rancheria conceptual master planning and furthers several priority capital improvement projects identified in the Trinidad Rancheria Transportation Plan

The Project will improve upon and build from the joint inter-agency cooperation (California Department of Transportation, Humboldt County Association of Governments, County of Humboldt, and Tribal) that created the Trinidad Area Freeway Master Plan Study Report Road, as well as the Cher-Ae Heights Indian Community of the Trinidad Rancheria Comprehensive Plan and Integrated Development Standards. For these reasons and more, the Humboldt County Board of Supervisors is in full support of this application and pledges to be an active partner in making this well thought out and long standing project a reality.
