SOURCE OF FUNDING:

Humboldt County Public Safety Realignment Allocation (3571-000-810520)

DISCUSSION:

The Humboldt County Community Corrections Partnership (HCCCP) voted March 21, 2018, to approve \$8,706 in funding to facilitate the purchase of computer software Cellebrite UFED Cloud Analyzer. from the numerous request from law enforcement agencies needing assistance collecting and preserving evidence from electronic devices and programs that utilize cloud based storage.

The nation is increasingly relying on cloud based digital technology and storage through electronic devices. Often as part of an investigation the cloud based technology can be analyzed during criminal investigations that often helps to understand all the complexities of an investigation and determine whether criminal activity has taken place. In the vast majority of criminal offenses, including those committed by persons released from prison pursuant to AB109 and on Post Release Community Supervision (PRCS), evidence of criminal activity is located on digital devices and their storage.

The District Attorney's Office provides all county and neighboring law enforcement agencies with digital forensic analysis when requested. An investigator within the District Attorney's Office is able to assist in digital evidence collection and preservation during this process. The Cloud Analyzer software is an addition to the District Attorney's current Cellebrite software package and will allow further analyzing of cloud based digital technology and storage. It is important for the District Attorney's Office to be able to provide complete forensic analysis during an investigation. The ability to access digital devices and storage must continue to advance in order to keep up with the advancements in technology used by criminals.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

The supplemental budget will increase the appropriation in the District Attorney's Office computer software object code (1100-205-2148) by \$8,706. The funding for this increase comes from the Humboldt County Public Safety Realignment Allocation, which has a current trust balance of \$5,027,117. There will be no impact on the county's General Fund.

This item supports the Board's strategic framework by enforcing laws and regulation to protect residents, protect vulnerable populations, and provide for and maintain infrastructure.
