As you are aware, Code Enforcement has an open case against your property located at 240 Central Ave, Fields Landing, CA, 95537, APN: 306-033-003, Case No: 16CEU-64.

A Notice to Abate Nuisance was issued against the property on or about July 1, 2019, for the following conditions creating a nuisance:

- HCC 354-1 junk and inoperable vehicles
- HCC 521-4 Improper Storage and Removal of Solid Waste
- HCC 311-10.1 Property/Building use in violation of zoning codes

You requested a Code Enforcement Appeal Hearing to contest CEU's determination that a nuisance existed on the property. The Code Enforcement Appeal Hearing was held on September 9, 2022, before Hearing Officer Wraymond Plummer with the California Hearing Officers.

On or about November 8, 2022, the Hearing Officer issued a Finding of Nuisance and Order of Abatement which upheld the Notice to Abate Nuisance and ordered that the owner remove all vehicles, trailers, boats, solid waste, salvaged materials, vehicle parts, and any or all other items from the property within 30 days of service of the Finding of Nuisance and Order of Abatement.

On June 5, 2023, (far exceeding the 30 days) you verbally consented to an inspection of the property while I was accompanied by a contractor who would potentially be providing an estimate for a County Abatement. Based on my observations of the property, progress was made to complete the corrective actions listed in the Finding of Nuisance and Order of Abatement, but items still remained including: a trailer, boat, vehicle parts, miscellaneous wood products, fence material, etc. With these items remaining on the property, you are in violation of the Hearing

Officer's Finding of Nuisance and Order of Abatement, giving CEU jurisdiction to abate the nuisance.

This letter is to notify you of Code Enforcement's intent to conduct an abatement of the public nuisance on your property.

Additionally, the costs of the required abatement may become a charge against your property and may be collected at the same time and in the same manner, and shall be subject to the same penalties, interest and procedure of foreclosure and sale in the case of delinquency, as is provided for ordinary property taxes. In addition, the costs may also become a charge against your property which has the same force, effect and priority of a judgement lien governed by the provisions of California Code of Civil Procedure Sections 697.31, et seq., and may be extended as provided in California Code of Civil Procedure Section 683.110, et deq.

Currently an Inspection Warrant and Order of Abatement is being drafted and sought in order to conduct a county abatement of the property. We are unsure when the abatement will commence but estimate around the beginning of December 2023.
