Dear Mr. McGuire,

As you are aware, Code Enforcement has an open case on your property located 240 Central Ave, Fields Landing, CA, APN: 306-033-003, Case Number 16CEU-64 for violations of Humboldt County Code related to junk and/or inoperable vehicles (HCC 354-1), the improper storage and removal of solid waste (HCC 521-1, 521-4, 521-12), and the property use in violation of Zoning Codes (311-10.1).

On July 8, 2019, you were served with a Notice to Abate Nuisance and a Notice of Violation and Proposed Administrative Civil Penalty for the conditions and violations observed on your property.

You requested a Code Enforcement Appeal Hearing and an Administrative Civil Penalty Appeal Hearing, which was held on September 9, 2022. The Hearing Officer upheld the Notice to Abate Nuisance and Notice of Violation and Proposed Administrative Civil Penalty and issued a Finding of Nuisance and Order of Abatement and a Finding of Violation and Order Imposing Administrative Civil Penalty which, in part, ordered a list of corrective actions to abate the nuisance on the property.

An inspection conducted on February 2, 2023, documented that the corrective actions had not been completed in the timeframe allowed by the Hearing Officer.

Consequently, the County has jurisdiction to abate the property.

This letter is to inform you that the County intends to move forward with abating the public nuisance, which includes but is not limited to the removal of solid waste and all items being stored on the property.

Additionally, the costs of the required abatement may become a charge against your property and


may be collected at the same time and in the same manner, and shall be subject to the same penalties, interest and procedure of foreclosure and sale in the case of delinquency, as is provided for ordinary property taxes. In addition, the costs may also become a charge against your property which has the same force, effect and priority of a judgement lien governed by the provisions of California Code of Civil Procedure Sections 697.31, et seq., and may be extended as provided in California Code of Civil Procedure Section 683.110, et seq.

The Code Enforcement Unit will need to conduct an inspection of the property with a contractor to provide an estimate for the abatement.

Subsequently, the Code Enforcement Unit is requesting a consent inspection of the property with said contractor. If you would like to consent to the inspection, please contact Code Enforcement to schedule the inspection. If I do not hear from you by **May 15, 2023**, I will assume you have denied the request for a consent inspection.


