Re: Letter of Commitment

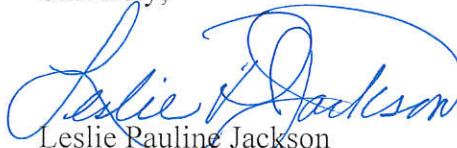
To Whom It May Concern:
