SUBJECT:

First Amendment to the Agreement for Consultant Services with Points West Surveying Company Regarding the Provision of On-Call Professional Land Surveying Services

RECOMMENDATION(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1. Approve, and authorize the Chair of the Board to execute, the attached first amendment to the agreement for consultant services with Point West Surveying Company regarding the provision of on-call professional land surveying services; and
- 2. Direct the Clerk of the Board to return two fully executed original copies of the attached first amendment to the Department of Public Works for further processing.

SOURCE OF FUNDING:

Humboldt County Road Fund (1200), Federal Highway Administration ("FHWA") Highway Bridge Program, the Toll Credit Bridge Replacement Fund and FHWA Storm Damage Funds, Federal Emergency Management Agency and California Office of Emergency Services

DISCUSSION:

On May 9, 2017, the Humboldt County Department of Public Works issued a Request for Qualification (RFQ) for the purpose of selecting a qualified consultant who will be available to meet the department's professional land surveying needs. The RFQ followed the selection process set forth in Chapter 10 of the California Department of Transportation's Local Assistance Procedures Manual. The statements of qualifications submitted in response to the RFQ for on-call professional land surveying services were evaluated and ranked by the selection committee. The highest ranking consultant was Points West Surveying Company, and the final ranking of the statements of qualifications was issued on June 2, 2017.

On January 9, 2018, the Board of Supervisors approved, and authorized the Chair of the Board to execute, a consultant services agreement with Points West Surveying Company, regarding the provision of professional land surveying services on an on-call basis (Attachment 1). The maximum amount payable for the services rendered, and costs and expenses incurred, pursuant to the terms and conditions of the consultant services agreement with Points West Surveying Company is currently \$430,000 for the period of January 9, 2018 through January 9, 2020.

The attached amendment (Attachment 2) will increase the maximum amount payable thereunder by \$450,000. Such an increase will allow for the provision of additional surveying services required to complete storm damage repairs and other necessary tasks, including, without limitation, construction staking and other services that are required to bring the county into compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act.

FIRST AMENDMENT AGREEMENT FOR CONSULTANT SERVICES BY AND BETWEEN COUNTY OF HUMBOLDT AND

POINTS WEST SURVEYING COMPANY FOR ON-CALL PROFESSIONAL LAND SURVEYING SERVICES

This First Amendment to the Agreement for Consultant Services dated January 9, 2018, by and between the County of Humboldt, a political subdivision of the State of California, hereinafter referred to as "COUNTY," and Points West Surveying Company, a California corporation, hereinafter referred to as "CONSULTANT," is entered into this 11 day of Detember, 2018.

WHEREAS, on January 9, 2018, COUNTY and CONSULTANT entered into an Agreement for Consultant Services regarding the provision of on-call professional land surveying services ("Consultant Services Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, the parties now desire to amend certain provisions of the Consultant Services Agreement to increase the maximum amount payable thereunder.

NOW THEREFORE, the parties mutually agree as follows:

1. Article V – Allowable Costs and Payments of the Consultant Services Agreement is hereby amended to read as follows:

ARTICLE V – ALLOWABLE COSTS AND PAYMENTS

- A. CONSULTANT will be reimbursed for hours worked at the hourly rates specified in CONSULTANT's Cost Proposal (Attachment B). The specified hourly rates shall include direct salary costs, employee benefits, overhead, and fee. These rates are not adjustable for the performance period set forth in this Contract.
- B. In addition, CONSULTANT will be reimbursed for incurred (actual) direct costs other than salary costs that are in the cost proposal and identified in the cost proposal and in the executed Task Order.
- C. Specific projects will be assigned to CONSULTANT through issuance of Task Orders.
- D. After a project to be performed under this contract is identified by COUNTY, COUNTY will prepare a draft Task Order; less the cost estimate. A draft Task Order will identify the scope of services, expected results, project deliverables, period of performance, project schedule and will designate a COUNTY Project Coordinator. The draft Task Order will be delivered to CONSULTANT for review. CONSULTANT shall return the draft Task Order within ten (10) calendar days along with a Cost Estimate, including a written estimate of the number of hours and hourly rates per staff person, any anticipated reimbursable expenses, overhead, fee if any, and total dollar amount. After agreement has been reached on the negotiable items and total cost; the finalized Task Order shall be signed by both COUNTY and CONSULTANT.

- E. Task Orders may be negotiated for a lump sum (Firm Fixed Price) or for specific rates of compensation, both of which must be based on the labor and other rates set forth in CONSULTANT's Cost Proposal.
- F. Reimbursement for transportation and subsistence costs shall not exceed the rates as specified in the approved Cost Proposal.
- G. When milestone cost estimates are included in the approved Cost Proposal, CONSULTANT shall obtain prior written approval for a revised milestone cost estimate from the Contract Administrator before exceeding such estimate.
- H. Progress payments for each Task Order will be made monthly in arrears based on services provided and actual costs incurred.
- I. CONSULTANT shall not commence performance of work or services until this contract has been approved by COUNTY, and notification to proceed has been issued by COUNTY's Contract Administrator. No payment will be made prior to approval, or for any work performed prior to approval, of this contract.
- J. A Task Order is of no force or effect until returned to COUNTY and signed by an authorized representative thereof. No expenditures are authorized on a project and work shall not commence until a Task Order for that project has been executed by COUNTY.
- K. CONSULTANT will be reimbursed, as promptly as fiscal procedures will permit upon receipt by COUNTY's Contract Administrator of itemized invoices in triplicate. Separate invoices itemizing all costs are required for all work performed under each Task Order. Invoices shall be submitted no later than 45 calendar days after the performance of work for which CONSULTANT is billing, or upon completion of the Task Order. Invoices shall detail the work performed on each milestone, on each project as applicable. Invoices shall follow the format stipulated for the approved Cost Proposal and shall reference this contract number, project title and Task Order number. Credits due COUNTY that include any equipment purchased under the provisions of Article XI Equipment Purchase of this contract, must be reimbursed by CONSULTANT prior to the expiration or termination of this contract. - L. The period of performance for Task Orders shall be in accordance with dates specified in the Task Order. No Task Order will be written which extends beyond the expiration date of this Contract.
- M. The total amount payable by COUNTY for an individual Task Order shall not exceed the amount agreed to in the Task Order, unless authorized by contract amendment.

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- N. If the Consultant fails to satisfactorily complete a deliverable according to the schedule set forth in a Task Order, no payment will be made until the deliverable has been satisfactorily completed.
- O. Task Orders may not be used to amend this Agreement and may not exceed the scope of work under this Agreement.
- P. The total amount payable by COUNTY for all Task Orders resulting from this contract shall not exceed Eight Hundred Eighty Thousand Dollars (\$880,000.00). It is understood and agreed that there is no guarantee, either expressed or implied that this dollar amount will be authorized under this contract through Task Orders.
- 2. The Consultant Services Agreement is hereby amended to delete Attachment B Cost Proposal ("Attachment B"), and replace it in its entirety with the modified version of Attachment B that is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference. The modified version of Attachment B attached hereto shall supersede any and all prior versions thereof, as of the effective date of this First Amendment.
- 3. The Consultant Services Agreement is hereby amended to delete Attachment D Consultant Certification of Contract Costs and Financial Management System (Exhibit 10-K) ("Attachment D"), and replace it in its entirety with the modified version of Attachment D that is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference. The modified version of Attachment D attached hereto shall supersede any and all prior versions thereof, as of the effective date of this First Amendment.
- 4. Except as modified herein, the Consultant Services Agreement dated January 9, 2018 shall remain in full force and effect. In the event of a conflict between the provisions of this First Amendment and the original Consultant Services Agreement, the provisions of this First Amendment shall govern.
