## Jacoby Creek Road Safety Committee

Attached is the application for funding for a speed table on Jacoby Creek Road. From the Bayside Post Office for about 2 miles, there is a straight stretch of road where some drivers drive highway/freeway speeds which is extremely dangerous. The speed limit is 25 by the Grange due to the school and extends a few hundred feet East, which is when it turns into 35mph. After about 1 ½ miles, the speed is again reduced to 25mph.

The reason the road is so straight and level is because it used to be the railway for lumber companies to remove logs while logging. Being so straight and level, some people tend to drive in excessive speeds and even pass others who are doing the speed limit.

There have been instances where people pulling from driveways are almost hit head on by vehicles passing cars who are doing the speed limit. Signs were made and placed along the road saying "Drive 35mph. Leave 10 seconds earlier", because that is the approximate amount of time that can be saved by driving 55-65 miles per hour instead of 35.

There are numerous people who walk with others and their dogs on a daily basis. There are also a lot of bike riders, including groups who come from Kneeland and end their ride driving West on Jacoby Creek Road to the end of the road. In many places the asphalt does not extend more than 12-18 inches past the outside white line. There are no walking or biking lanes because there is no room for them.

The request for a speed table about the 3000 block of Jacoby Creek Road would be approximately ½ way down the straight stretch of road is is where many vehicles are excessively speeding and actually pass other vehicles. The Arcata Fire Department said they would not object to a speed table but would object to a speed hump so they have initially approved our idea.

CHP has been asked on numerous occasions to come out and run radar. We have requested 1 hour per month but they are understaffed.

The placement of the speed table is where most passing has occurred and where there are few homes. There have been accidents on Jacoby Creek Road when vehicles are turning into driveways, signaling and someone tries to pass.

It is our hope slowing the driving to a safer level will make it safer for pedestrians, bicyclists and drivers combined. Our community realizes \$4,000 may not pay the full cost of the installation of the speed table but we would be willing to obtain donations to make up the balance. Please help us make Bayside safer for all.

Several pedestrians have almost been hit on Jacoby Creek Road so this is a major concern. We have heard the speed tables installed on Freshwater Road are working and have made things much safer. Freshwater has more room for pedestrians and bicyclists so this is more important for our residents.
