

**THIRD AMENDMENT  
MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING  
BY AND BETWEEN  
COUNTY OF HUMBOLDT  
AND  
CRESTWOOD BEHAVIORAL HEALTH, INC.  
FOR FISCAL YEARS 2011-2012 THROUGH 2022-2023**

This Third Amendment to the Memorandum of Understanding for emergency evacuation services dated July 2, 2012, as amended on April 26, 2016 and February 19, 2019, by and between the County of Humboldt, a political subdivision of the State of California, hereinafter referred to as "COUNTY," and Crestwood Behavioral Health, Inc., a Delaware corporation, hereinafter referred to as "CONTRACTOR," is entered into this 21 day of May, 2020.

WHEREAS, COUNTY, by and through its Department of Health and Human Services – Behavioral Health ("DHHS – Behavioral Health"), desired to provide for the evacuation of patients from the COUNTY's Inpatient Psychiatric Health Facility in the event of fire or natural disaster or as otherwise ordered by the Fire Marshall or the DHHS – Behavioral Health Director; and

WHEREAS, on July 2, 2012, COUNTY and CONTRACTOR entered into a Memorandum of Understanding regarding the provision of such emergency evacuation services; and

WHEREAS, on April 26, 2016, COUNTY and CONTRACTOR amended the Memorandum of Understanding to extend the term thereof and update the contact list attached thereto as Exhibit A – Agency Liaisons; and

WHEREAS, on February 19, 2019, COUNTY and CONTRACTOR amended the Memorandum of Understanding to update the contact list attached thereto as Exhibit A – Agency Liaisons and to include a provision regarding counterpart execution therein; and

WHEREAS, the parties now desire to amend certain provisions of the Memorandum of Understanding to extend the term thereof and modify the execution requirements set forth therein.

NOW THEREFORE, the parties mutually agree as follows:

1. Section IX – Term of the Memorandum of Understanding is hereby amended to read as follows:

**IX. TERM:**

The term of this MOU shall begin on June 1, 2012 and shall remain in full force and effect until June 30, 2023.

2. Section X – Counterpart Execution of the Memorandum of Understanding is hereby amended to read as follows:

**X. COUNTERPART EXECUTION:**

This MOU, and any amendments hereto, may be executed in one (1) or more counterparts, each of which shall be deemed to be an original and all of which, when taken together, shall be deemed to be one (1) and the same agreement. This MOU, and any amendments hereto, may be signed by manual or electronic signatures in accordance with any and all applicable local, state and federal laws, regulations and

standards, and such signatures shall constitute original signatures for all purposes. A signed copy of this MOU, and any amendments hereto, transmitted by email or by other means of electronic transmission shall be deemed to have the same legal effect as delivery of an original executed copy of this MOU, and any amendments hereto.

3. Except as modified herein, the Memorandum of Understanding dated July 2, 2012, as amended on April 26, 2016 and February 19, 2019, shall remain in full force and effect. In the event of a conflict between the provisions of this Third Amendment and the original Memorandum of Understanding, or any prior amendments thereto, the provisions of this Third Amendment shall govern.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties have entered into this Third Amendment as of the first date written above.


