

SUMMARY FOR PUBLICATION PRIOR TO ADOPTION OF ORDINANCE

SUMMARY

On March 8, 2022, at its regularly scheduled Board meeting, the Humboldt County Board of Supervisors will consider for adoption a proposed ordinance revising Sections 712-2(b) and 712-3 of Chapter 2 to Division 1 of Title VII of the Humboldt County Code, relating to amendments to the transient occupancy tax to update the definition of "living space" and change the transient occupancy tax rate from 10 to 12 percent. The proposed amended tax will be used for general purposes. These amendments to the transient occupancy tax ordinance shall be operative if a majority of the electors voting on the measure vote to approve at an election to be held on June 7, 2022, pursuant Government Code Section 53723.
