On April 10, 2018, during its regularly scheduled Board meeting, the Humboldt County Board of Supervisors adopted Ordinance No. _____.

These amendments to the Local Coastal Program (LCP) update local regulations for cultivation, processing, manufacturing, distribution, testing, and sale of commercial cannabis consistent with state law. The ordinance amendments are part of ongoing efforts to regulate land uses associated with commercial cannabis in the county. The proposed ordinance amendments modify the existing regulations governing where within the county commercial cultivation, processing, manufacturing, and distribution of cannabis for medical and adult use can occur, and the permitting structure for county oversight of these activities. The proposed ordinance would apply within the unincorporated areas of Humboldt County in the Coastal Zone.

The Ordinance would amend Section 313-55.4 et seq. of Title III, Division I, Chapter 3, Section B, Part 1 (Coastal Zoning Regulations), of the Humboldt County Code. The proposed amendments would also repeal the Medical Cannabis Testing and Research Laboratories provisions and on-site consumption prohibition found in Sections 313-55.3.15 and 313-55.3.11.7 of Division I of Title III of the County Code because these provisions are incorporated into the proposed amendments. The ordinance shall become effective immediately after certification by the California Coastal Commission.

The proposed amendments would also repeal of the Medical Cannabis Testing and Research Laboratories provisions and on-site consumption prohibition found in Sections 314-55.3.15 and 314-55.3.11.7 of Division 1 of Title III of the County Code because these provisions are incorporated into the proposed amendments. The ordinance amendments apply throughout the unincorporated areas of Humboldt County, outside of the Coastal Zone. The ordinance shall become effective 30 days after adoption.
