WHEREAS, the depth and breadth of the registered nursing profession meets the different and emerging health care needs of the American population in a wide range of settings; and

WHEREAS, a renewed emphasis on primary and preventive health care will require utilization of all of our nation's nursing resources, and

WHEREAS, nurses are a part of prevention, primary care and long-term care in hospitals, clinics and community, public health, mental health and long-term care facilities; and

WHEREAS, more than 90 nurses in the Humboldt County Department of Health & Human Services (DHHS) work to create a nurturing, supportive, healthy environment for Humboldt County children, families, adults and communities through innovative and integrative efforts between Public Health, Mental Health, Social Services, education and medical professionals; and

WHEREAS, National Nurses Week provides an opportunity to honor the work of DHHS nurses and all community nurses in their ongoing effort to promote, protect and enhance the health and safety of all residents in our county.
