**WHEREAS**, Correctional Officer Bittner was trained and assigned as a department Firearms Instructor in March 1999 and has continued to this day; and

**WHEREAS**, Correctional Officer Bittner was promoted to a Senior Correctional Officer in December 2000; and

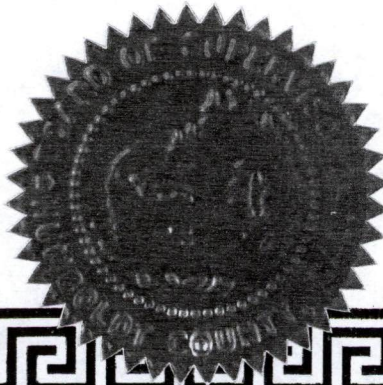
**WHEREAS**, Senior Correctional Officer Bittner was appointed to Acting Correctional Supervisor in September 2003 for a period of eight (8) months; and


