Thank you for consulting the California Coastal Commission regarding the submission of the PG&E coastal development permit application (PLN- 2025-19272). After reviewing the provided application materials, we have the following feedback and suggestions:

Att 06 Cultural Resource Summary identifies recorded cultural resources near the API with 33% of the area surveyed. It also addressed environmental factors that could contribute to potential for additional resources to be found in the un-surveyed portions of the API. Because there are recorded resources and there is potential for cultural resources in the rest of the project area, we suggest conditioning the project to require tribal consultation for work areas 1-13, 20-52, 74-92, 95-111 consistent with County regulations (313-16) and HBAP (3.18).

Att 05 Biological Constraints Report identified riparian shrub habitat (74-86 and 90-99), freshwater forested shrub wetland (85-87), and freshwater emergent wetlands (94 and 95). Per the ERA and SCAP 3.41 (f) removal of trees within wetlands shall retain snags where possible.
