NATIONAL CRIME VICTIMS' RIGHTS WEEK

WHEREAS, since 1982, the District Attorney Victim Witness Office has provided services to thousands of crime victims, witnesses and their families each year: and

WHEREAS, victims of crime, and their loved ones, often face severe financial, physical and psychological trauma: and

WHEREAS, Victim Witness Advocates and other staff are available to answer questions and help victims and their families cope with the trauma they have experienced, as well as the often complicated criminal justice system: and

WHEREAS, an effective and fair criminal justice system must recognize the rights of victims and balance them with those of the accused: and

WHEREAS, all agencies are encouraged to strengthen partnerships to coordinate direct and referral services to crime victims: and

WHEREAS, all citizens are encouraged to increase their awareness of the impact of violent crime, the needs of crime victims and the vital services DA Victim Witness has to offer.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED that the Humboldt County Board of Supervisors, recognizes April 19-25, 2026 as National Crime Victims' Rights Week and expresses appreciation to the District Attorney Victim Witness Office for the 44 years of dedicated service to the citizens of Humboldt County.
