Dear Board of Supervisors:

The County of Humboldt Housing Authority is requesting the removal of a board member. Commissioner Janice Price has not attended a meeting in person in over a year and a half, and all attempts to contact via phone and mail have failed to produce positive contact. Though our bylaws do not have an attendance requirement, it is essential to our ability to continue operations that we have a full and participating board.

Per California Health and Safety Code Division 24. Community Development and Housing, Part 2. Housing Authorities, Article 3. Officers and Employees, Section 34282:

“For inefficiency, neglect of duty, or misconduct in office, a commissioner may be removed by the governing body of the county in the case of a county authority, or by the mayor, if he has the power of appointment of commissioners, otherwise, by the governing body of the city in the case of a city authority. A commissioner shall be removed only after he has been given a copy of the charges at least 10 days prior to the hearing on them and has had an opportunity to be heard in person or by counsel. If a commissioner is removed, a record of the proceedings and the charges and findings on them shall be filed in the office of the clerk.” (*Added by Stats. 1951, Ch. 710.*)

We have made repeated attempts to make contact with the commissioner, to no avail. Based on the recommendation of our active board members, the code as noted above, and commissioner Price’s lack of contact and participation, we are requesting the formal removal of Janice Price from the Board of Commissioners.
