

WHEREAS, the National Geographic Bee is a program of the prestigious National Geographic Society; and

WHEREAS, Decho states that for as long as he can remember, he's been fascinated by geography and history, and says he's always been interested in looking at maps, adding that he wants to be an architectural engineer when he grows up; and

WHEREAS, Decho enjoys learning how countries established their borders, which comes in handy during geography bees; and

WHEREAS, Decho prepared for the bee by using educational apps and online quizzes to test his knowledge; and

WHEREAS, Decho won his most recent school geography bee and qualified for the state bee after taking an online test; and

WHEREAS, Decho is the first student from Humboldt County to qualify for the National Geographic State Bee, an achievement due in part to Decho's geography knowledge and time spent reading.
