

PROCLAMATION
of the
Board of Supervisors
County of Humboldt

WHEREAS, the nearly 3 million registered nurses in the U.S. comprise our nation's largest health care profession; and

WHEREAS, the depth and breadth of the nursing profession meets the different and emerging health care needs of the American population in a wide range of settings; and

WHEREAS, a renewed emphasis on primary and preventive health care will require utilization of all of our nation's licensed professional nursing resources; and

WHEREAS, professional nursing has been demonstrated to be an indispensable component in the safety and quality of care of hospitalized patients; and

WHEREAS, nurses are a part of prevention, primary care, and long term care in settings that involve hospitals, clinics, community, public health, mental health and long-term care facilities; and

WHEREAS, more than 70 nurses in the Humboldt County Department of Health & Human Services work to create a nurturing, supportive, healthy environment for Humboldt County children, families, adults and communities through innovative and integrative efforts with other public health, mental health, social services, education and medical professionals; and

WHEREAS, National Nurses Week provides an opportunity to honor the efforts of Humboldt County Department of Health & Human Services nurses and all community nurses in their ongoing effort to promote, protect and enhance the health and safety of all residents in our county.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Humboldt County Board of Supervisors, in recognition of National Nurses Week, hereby proclaims **May 6-12, 2016 as Nurses Week** in Humboldt County and asks that all residents of Humboldt County join in honoring the nurses who care for all of us; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Humboldt County residents celebrate nursing's accomplishments and efforts to improve our health care system and show our appreciation for the nation's nurses not just during this week, but at every opportunity throughout the year.
