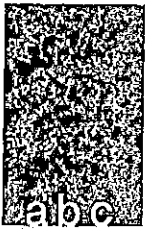
Anne Bown-Crawford is a senior consultant, policy leader, interdisciplinary artist, and educator whose work spans placemaking, culture, and creative education across public, academic, and governmental contexts. Her career bridges systems-level policy development with studio-based and research-driven artistic practice, with a focus on how arts and culture shape civic life, innovation, and community well-being.

She currently serves as Senior Executive Advisor to California State Parks' Arts in Parks program, where she designs and implements initiatives that integrate public art into natural landscapes—merging environmental stewardship with cultural enrichment. She also advises the CA Jobs First Sustainable Recreation & Tourism Cohort, the Arts, Culture, and Tourism Advisory Council, and the Great Redwood Trail Public Arts Advisory Council.

From 2017 to 2022, Bown-Crawford served as Executive Director of the California Arts Council, appointed by Governor Jerry Brown and reappointed by Governor Gavin Newsom. During her tenure, she led a significant expansion of the agency's vision, advancing arts and culture as essential to equity, economic development, and public life. She developed and implemented major statewide initiatives, including the CA Creative Corps, and expanded investment in creative education, cultural districts, accessibility, and workforce development. Under her leadership, the agency's budget grew from \$26 million to \$172 million through a strategic alignment of narrative, policy, and public value.

Parallel to her policy work, Bown-Crawford maintains an active interdisciplinary practice as an Artist in Residence with Google's Quantum AI Research Labs in collaboration with DrawEverywhere Studios. Her work in this context explores the intersection of art, science, and innovation, using iterative, collaborative processes to engage scientists in visual inquiry and creative exchange. This work reflects her broader commitment to integrating artistic thinking into complex systems and research environments.

Across all areas of her work, she is committed to building partnerships that connect arts, culture, science, and nature to advance more inclusive, creative, and resilient communities.

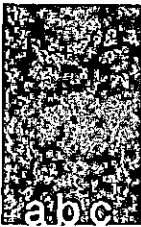

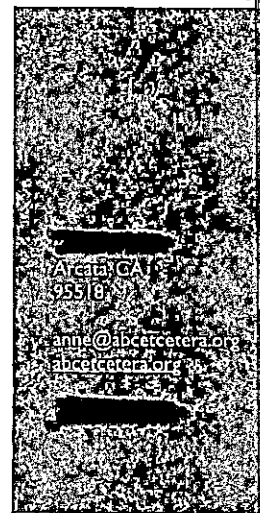
