

Agricultural Commissioner as required by the county's medical marijuana ordinance section 55.4.15 Humboldt Artisanal Branding should begin charging an inspection and certification fee to recover the costs of said inspections by the Agricultural Commissioner during the pilot project, or whether these inspection services were intended to be a contribution from the General Fund. Staff has been working with the Agricultural Commissioner to determine an appropriate time to begin charging the inspection and certification fee. This fee could be added during the upcoming fee update in September, or sooner if the Board desires and could be in effect by July.
