RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF AVENUE OF THE GIANTS AND CONTROLLED TRAFFIC ON THE MATTOLE ROAD FOR SIX RIVERS RUNNING CLUB'S 44<sup>th</sup> ANNUAL AVENUE OF THE GIANTS MARATHON, HALF MARATHON AND 10K RACE ON SUNDAY, MAY 3, 2015

**WHEREAS**, the Six Rivers Running Club is planning the 44<sup>th</sup> Annual Avenue of the Giants Marathon, Half Marathon, and 10K Race for Sunday, May 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2015 between the hours of 7:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m., and is requesting that the following specific sections of closure and control are:

- 1. Both lanes of Highway 254 from the southern Redcrest exit from Highway 101 to 6.55 miles south of Dyerville Bridge closed to all traffic but official race and emergency vehicles. People attending church or leaving/returning home would be allowed to pass; and
- 2. Both lanes of the Mattole Road controlled by Eureka Volunteer Patrol (EVP) pilot cars from the Dyerville Bridge (Honeydew Founders Tree exit from Highway 101) to a point 6.55 miles west on the Mattole Road.

Request for Temporary Road Closure

Dear Supervisor Fennell:

The Six Rivers Running Club would appreciate it if you could place the following road closure request on the Humboldt County Board of Supervisors agenda. Although our event is not scheduled until May 3, 2015, the resolution is an early step in our multiagency permitting process. We appreciate the Board of Supervisor's consideration of our request.

The Six Rivers Running Club is requesting a temporary closure of the Avenue of the Giants and controlled traffic on the Mattole Road for the 44th Annual Avenue of the Giants Marathon, Half Marathon and 10K Race to be held on Sunday, May 3<sup>th</sup>, 2015 from 7:30 A.M. to 2:30 P.M.

The specific closure and traffic control areas are:

- 1. Both lanes of Highway 254 from the southern Redcrest exit from Highway 101 to 6.55 miles south of the Dyerville Bridge. During the event Highway 254 will be closed to all traffic except for official race and emergency vehicles. People attending church or leaving/returning home would also be allowed to pass.
- 2. Both lanes of the Mattole Road will be controlled by Eureka Volunteer Patrol (EVP) pilot cars from the Dyerville Bridge (Honeydew Founders' Tree exit from Highway 101) to a point 6.55 miles west on the Mattole Road.

As in previous years, the closure and controlled traffic areas will be subject to review and approval by Caltrans and the CHP. Additionally, the race will be noticed in local newspapers and public transportation and emergency agencies will be notified.

Please forward a copy of the portion of proceedings pertaining to the road closure and Board of Supervisor's Resolution to Six Rivers Running Club. Enclosed is a return envelope.
