<u>DISCUSSION</u>: Assembly Member Mark Stone has introduced legislation which would provide additional funding for of the California Advanced Services Fund (CASF), which was created to assist providers in deploying broadband to rural and remote places.

AB1748 sets a goal of 98% broadband deployment throughout every region in California; 90% of all households online by 2023; and authorizes funding to assist low-income households get online.

Redwood Coast Connect has been asked by the author to reach out to the Board of Supervisors to consider a letter in support.

Dear Assemblymember Stone:

The Humboldt County Board of Supervisors wishes to express our support for AB1758 (Stone), the Internet For All Now Act of 2016, which would add needed funding and improve management of the California Advanced Services Fund (CASF).

AB1758 is essential to ensure the State meets the Legislature's statutory goal to achieve 98% broadband deployment in every region of California. The measure sets a new goal of 90% adoption by 2023 and authorizes funding to assist low-income households to get online so that our most disadvantaged residents can be included in the Digital Economy.

AB1758 is not an increase in fees or taxes—it continues an existing collection that is a few cents a month for telecommunications customers. In fact, CASF was established by the Legislature in 2008 by reducing a fee that previously was collected to subsidize telephone service and rededicated it to broadband infrastructure.

We commend you on your commitment to help close the digital divide in California.
