**POST-ADOPTION SUMMARY OF URGENCY ORDINANCE EXTENDING A
TEMPORARY MORATORIUM ON SHORT-TERM RENTALS WITHIN THE
UNINCORPORATED AREAS OF HUMBOLDT COUNTY, WHICH SHALL TAKE
IMMEDIATE EFFECT**

On Tuesday, _____, 2023 during its regularly scheduled Board meeting, the Humboldt County Board of Supervisors adopted urgency Ordinance No. _____, to take immediate effect, to extend the urgent temporary moratorium on short-term rentals within the unincorporated area of the County of Humboldt. The moratorium is in effect for 22 months and 15 days after enactment.
