Re: 41st Annual Humboldt Redwoods Marathon
Request for Temporary Road Closure

Dear Supervisor Fennell:

The Six Rivers Running Club would appreciate the placement of the following road closure request on the Humboldt County Board of Supervisors agenda. Although our event is not scheduled until October 13, 2019, the resolution, required by Caltrans and the California Highway Patrol, is an early step in our multi-agency permitting process. We sincerely appreciate the Board of Supervisors' consideration of our request.

The Six Rivers Running Club is requesting a temporary closure of the Avenue of the Giants, and controlled traffic on the Mattole Road for the 40th Annual Humboldt Redwoods Marathon, Half Marathon and 5K Race on Sunday, October 13, 2019 from 9:00 A.M. to 4:00 P.M.

The specific closure and traffic control areas are:

1. Both lanes of Highway 254 from the southern Redcrest exit of Highway 101 to a point 6.55 miles south of the Dyerville Bridge. Route 254 will be closed to all traffic except for official race and emergency vehicles. Citizens attending church or leaving and returning home will also be allowed to pass through the temporary closure areas.
2. The Bull Creek/Mattole Road, leading west from the Dyerville Bridge, will be subject to piloted traffic, controlled by Eureka Volunteer Patrol (EVP) pilot cars. Piloted traffic will extend for a distance of 6.55 miles west on the Mattole Road.

As in previous years, the closure and control traffic areas will be reviewed by Caltrans and the CHP.

Special Event Permits for the will be obtained from the County of Humboldt, California State Parks and Caltrans. Emergency Service agencies will be involved in event coordination and staged on site during the event.

Thank you for your continued support of our two major marathons (The Avenue of the Giants Marathon and the Humboldt Redwoods Marathon). Both events showcase the beauty of our County, bringing runners and their families to the North Coast from all over the United States.

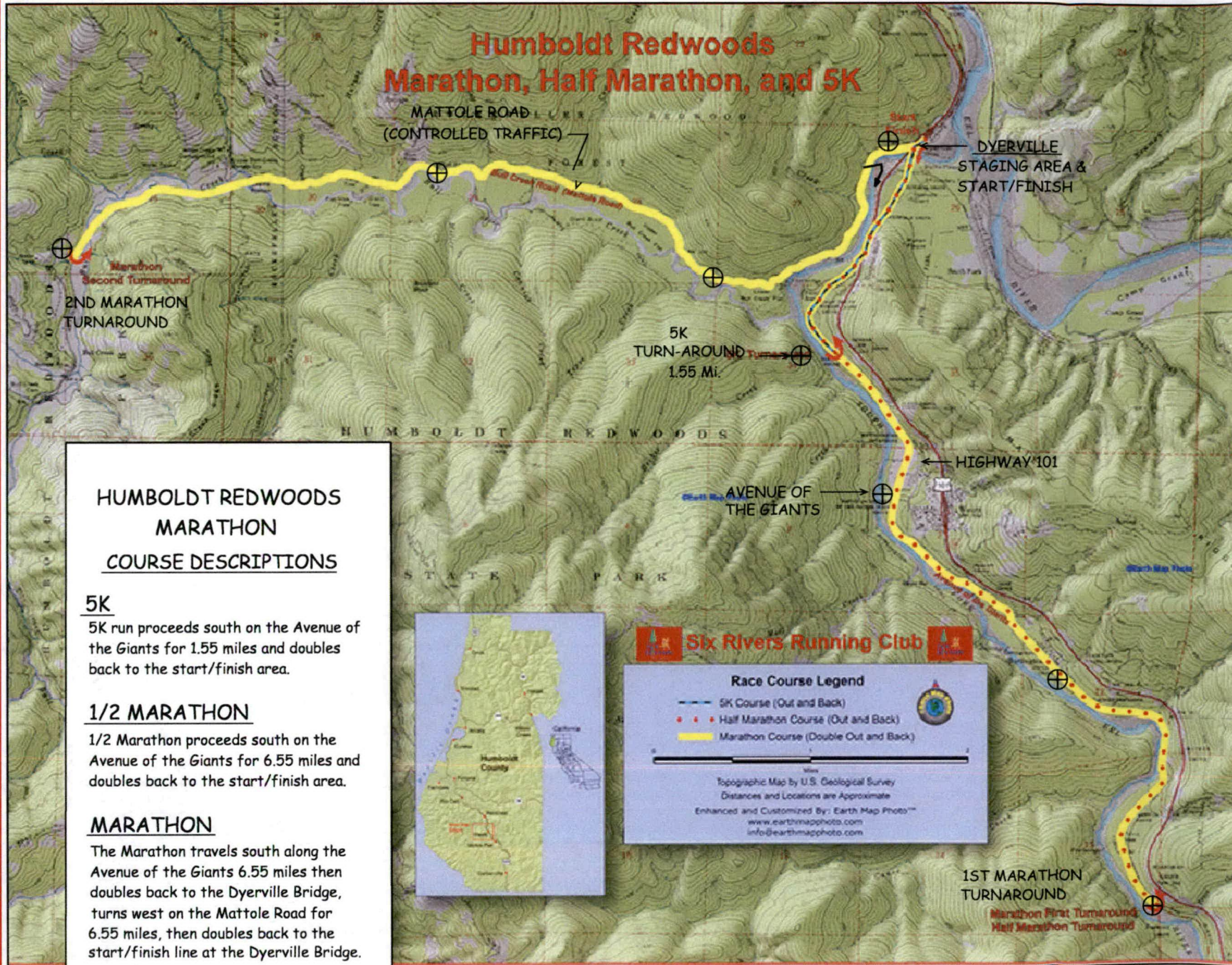

5K

5K run proceeds south on the Avenue of the Giants for 1.55 miles and doubles back to the start/finish area.

1/2 MARATHON

1/2 Marathon proceeds south on the Avenue of the Giants for 6.55 miles and doubles back to the start/finish area.

MARATHON

The Marathon travels south along the Avenue of the Giants 6.55 miles then doubles back to the Dyerville Bridge, turns west on the Mattole Road for 6.55 miles, then doubles back to the start/finish line at the Dyerville Bridge.
