#### DISCUSSION:

The Humboldt County Public Works, Heavy Equipment Division is requesting authorization to enter into a purchase agreement for a 544K-II Loader. The loader will replace the 1987 John Deere loader damaged in an accident on January 23, 2018. The damaged Tier 0, 1987 John Deere loader, once declared surplus by the Board, will be used for parts to repair additional aging equipment. Public Works opted to purchase new equipment at Tier 4 Final, as opposed to repairing aging equipment rated at Tier 0, due to the fact that the older equipment no longer meets the State of California's emission requirements. In addition, parts for 1987 equipment have become increasingly difficult to find. The proposed loader the Public Works Heavy Equipment Department intends to purchase, is rated Tier 4 Final, which meets the State of California's emission requirements. The total purchase cost will be \$185,000 and the equipment will be in high demand in the spring and summer months.

If the Board approves the purchase of the 544K-II loader, the existing damaged loader will be declared surplus and cannibalized for parts.

The Department received proposals (Attachment 1) from two companies for the loader (listed below); the third company did not respond:

No. 1. Road Machinery at \$202,939.08

No. 2. Pape Machinery at \$184,171.87

The best price was Pape Machinery on a contract price of \$184,171.87, which includes sales tax, shipping and license fees.

The Department chose to purchase the new equipment outright as the previous equipment has already been fully depreciated. Roads Heavy Equipment ISF (3540330) will be responsible for capitalization, maintenance and insurance.

#### **FINANCIAL IMPACT**:

The total purchase price of the new equipment is \$185,000. Roads Heavy Equipment (3540330) will bear the full cost of the purchase using cash from the fund balance. The request, if granted, will transfer \$185,000 from the Fund Balance Transfer line item 3450330-710050 to the Loader line item 3450330-8762. There is no impact to the General Fund.

This equipment supports the Board's Strategic Framework by managing resources to ensure the sustainability of services that the county provides to the public.

#### **OTHER AGENCY INVOLVEMENT:**

None.

### ALTERNATIVES TO STAFF RECOMMENDATIONS:

The Board could choose to repair the outdated Tier 0 equipment but this equipment would need to be placed out of service eventually to meet emission standards. The Board may also postpone the purchase but that would require the continued costly rental of a loader. Either of these options are not recommended.
