Subject:

Compensation Adjustment for Treasurer-Tax Collector

RECOMMENDATION(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1. Approve a 5% increase in base pay for the position of Treasurer-Tax Collector (class 0100) for added responsibilities due to the transfer of the Revenue Recovery Team from the County Administrative Office to the Treasurer-Tax Collector's Office as of July 1, 2016, effective at the beginning of the next pay period following approval;
- 2. Adopt Resolution No. <u>110-83</u> amending Attachment 2 of the Compensation Plan for Appointed and Elected Department Heads.

SOURCE OF FUNDING: Treasurer-Tax Collector, BU 112

DISCUSSION:

The Board has adopted a Compensation Plan for Management and Confidential Employees and Appointed and Elected Department Heads. The Compensation Plan for Appointed and Elected Department Heads, Exhibit B, provides a process for evaluating additional compensation for department heads based on changes in responsibility.

Pursuant to the language in the Compensation Plan regarding increased responsibilities, Treasurer-Tax Collector John Bartholomew requested consideration for an additional 5% in compensation for taking on additional responsibilities due to the transfer of the Revenue Recovery Team from the County Administrative Office to the Treasurer-Tax Collector's Office effective July 1, 2016. This occurred pursuant to your Board's action of May 10, 2016 authorizing that transfer.

The recommended salary increase is made in accordance with a provision within the Compensation Plan for Elected and Appointed Department Heads, providing for increased compensation for Added Workload/Staffing/Program Responsibilities. The provision of the agreement allows for increases in compensation in the 5-10% range. This instant request for additional compensation relative to services provided for the transition of Revenue Recovery was evaluated by the County Administrative Officer and the Human Resources Director and additional compensation of 5% is recommended. To effectuate this, a resolution amending the compensation plan is necessary. Such a resolution is attached for the Board's consideration.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

The monthly salary increase is \$501.00. Total annual cost including benefits would be approximately \$6,012.00.

This action supports your Board's strategic framework by investing in County employees and building interjurisdictional and regional cooperation.

OTHER AGENCY INVOLVEMENT: None

ALTERNATIVES TO STAFF RECOMMENDATIONS:

Your Board could decline to provide additional compensation for the position of Treasurer-Tax Collector. This alternative is not recommended as the past practice of the County has been to provide increased compensation to reward/incentivize staff when assuming additional responsibilities.
