## SEMPERVIRENS PSYCHIATRIC HEALTH FACILITY CLINICAL DIRECTOR STATEMENT OF QUALIFICATIONS AND DUTIES

The Clinical Director is primarily responsible for business and support services for the clinical program for Sempervirens Psychiatric Health Facility.

The Clinical Director will direct the clinical program for Sempervirens Psychiatric Health Facility, provide general direction to professional and non-professional staff and will be responsible for the quality of clinical services performed in Sempervirens.

The Clinical Director will monitor and evaluate the quality and appropriateness of clinical activities in the Facility.

The Clinical Director will assure compliance with appropriate regulations and oversee and assure that there are comprehensive Quality Assurance and Utilization Review programs in place.

The Clinical Director will serve on committees regarding quality improvement, utilization review, infection control, pharmacy, therapeutics and other committees as required.

The Clinical Director will be a behavioral health professional licensed by the State of California's Board of Behavioral Sciences.

The Clinical Director will have at least three years of post-graduate direct clinical experience with individuals with mental illness.

The Clinical Director shall have direct lines of communication with the Hospital Administrator for coordination of services and general business of the Facility.

The Clinical Director will report to the Behavioral Health Director, or designee.
