RE: CCLUO Review Meeting on June 13th

Dear Director Ford:

I live in Fortuna within the area addressed by the Nelson Hillside Association (NHA).

I have written letters previously to Supervisor Fennell, and to Steve Lazar regarding the proposed cannabis sites: 12157, 12158, and 12160.

With regard to this particular meeting, I have the following inputs.

I personally call for you to direct staff to create Exclusion Zones, that prohibit any form of Commercial Cannabis Operation. An Exclusion Zone would be defined as:

1. All areas within 1,000' of a City Limit boundary;
2. All areas within a City Sphere of Influence (SOI);
3. All established rural neighborhoods, not covered by the above, and
4. Any development outside the Exclusion Zone have a mandatory 500' setback from any residential home. This protects the perimeter of the residents within the Exclusion Zone.

These are the setbacks that Bill Thorington of the NHA suggested. I echo his suggestions here, with the comment that I believe them to be quite generous. I prefer, and have previously requested much larger size for the Exclusion Zones.

The annexation process of the Nelson Lane County lands has already begun in Fortuna. Residents have voted 100% for annexation and a request to the Fortuna City Council is currently under review. We await a resolution to formally begin the process.

I call on you to adopt the concept of an Exclusion Zone around cities and their SOI's. While we need to locate new cannabis grows and relocate some remote cannabis operations in closer, for

reasons that I support, they do not belong in the middle of established neighborhoods filled with families, children and pets.
