<u>RECOMMENDATION(S)</u>: That the Board of Supervisors authorize the Chair to sign the letter of support.

<u>DISCUSSION</u>: The Public Law Library of Humboldt County is asking the Board of Supervisors to send a letter of support for State Budget Appropriations to be distributed to County Law Libraries across the state. County Law Libraries are asking for 16.5 million dollars in California's final state budget to be submitted in mid-June. County Law Libraries play a critical role in providing the public with access to California's legal system and without funding allocation for County Law Libraries, that access will be severely diminished. The Law Library serves the bench, the bar and the public.

The Humboldt County Board of Supervisors join efforts of Senators McGuire, Wieckowski, Skinner, Berryhill and Dodd; along with Assembly Members Lackey, Bonta, Levine, Rubio, Burke, Gallagher and Mathis; and the County Boards of Supervisors in Butte, Glenn, Marin, and Nevada as well as Law Library Boards of Trustees throughout California, to help end the chronic underfunding of California Law Libraries.

Re: Support for California Law Libraries

Honorable Governor Brown:

On behalf of the Humboldt County Board of Supervisors, we are writing to ask that you include supplemental funding for California County Law Libraries in the upcoming 2018 budget.

County Law Libraries serve an important public service for all California residents. County Law Libraries provide needed and necessary access to legal information for Californians who are without the means to hire a lawyer and would be without help but for their local public law library. More than 80% of litigants in matters of eviction, foreclosure, child custody and support proceedings, and debt collection cases are without benefit of paid counsel. These libraries are funded almost exclusively from civil court filing fees and because of that, the funding has decreased nearly below 40% of the amount received in 2009. This is making this valuable service difficult to maintain.

Therefore, without County Law Libraries, most people have no access to legal information and therefore no access to justice. We respectfully encourage you to support this important fund appropriation in the January 2018 budget proposal.

# Re: County Law Libraries' Request for Funding in the Governor's 2018 Proposed Budget and in Successive State Budgets

A Butte County Board of Supervisors Resolution (10/10/2017) Was Adopted A Glenn County Board of Supervisors (11/07/2017) Was Adopted A Humboldt County Board of Supervisors Resolution is Urged

Dear Ms. Bass:

Pending before Governor Brown is a Request that a line-item include County Law Libraries in the State Budget. By Statute, every California County has a law library fund, the size of which depends upon the number of local filings in its Superior Court.

"It is the intent of the Legislature for California to continue its century old tradition of making legal materials available to all its citizens via adequately funded, staffed, and maintained county law libraries. ... County boards of supervisors are charged with the responsibility of monitoring the needs of the county law library within their respective jurisdictions and adjusting filing fees as permitted by the provisions of that chapter to enable the county law library to fulfill its defined mission." (Stats. 1990, Ch. 56, Sec. 7)

Until 2008, County Boards of Supervisors had authority to adjust filing fees as permitted by Business and Professions Code sections 6321, 6322 and 6322.1. Prior to 2005, counties were empowered to allocate local fees to defray the expenses of the law library. (Stats. 1990, Ch. 56, Sec. 1) These fees would be in addition to the standard court fees established by State Law. The Uniform Civil Fee and Standard Fee Schédule Act of 2005 eliminated this local power, but

preserved County Boards of Supervisors' authority to direct the Administrative Office of the Courts to reallocate distribution of the standard fees each year by an additional three dollars (\$3) per filing to the Law Library Fund. The board of supervisors' authority was terminated by a legislative moratorium of January 1, 2008, which remains in effect.

### **Funds Receipts Declined**

Distributions to the Law Library Fund Statewide have dropped by approximately 35 to 40 percent in the past eight years, limited as they are by the single source of those distributions (court fees), and by mandatory arbitration provisions and other factors that have also reduced this single-source of revenue. This is a loss of important local money. Law Libraries in all counties have lost funding, but it is worse in the smaller counties.

To restore adequate receipts and reestablish diversified resources, a Statewide effort is under way. Law Library governing boards and concerned professional patrons are urging Boards of Supervisors to adopt Resolutions supporting legislation for a line-item allocation in the State Budged from the General Fund for county law libraries; supporters urge Legislators to sign-on to a petition to the Governor to add the line-item in his 2018 Proposed Budget this January. It is an all-counties effort: The funding requested of Governor Brown is \$16.5 million. It would give each county law library supplemental funding beginning in Fiscal Year 2018 equal to court fees received in 2009. Assemblyman Jim Wood will be urged to sign the petition – with the backing of the Butte, Colusa, Glenn, Sutter, Tehama, and Yuba County Boards of Supervisors – in November.

Butte and Glenn counties have acted – and Humboldt is urged to join forces. County law libraries and citizens of each county are dependent on funds. –Law libraries of the North State – as a region – have among the fewest funding resources of any region in the State. It is critical that Humboldt join with this statewide effort to adopt Resolutions urging Governor Brown to provide for county law libraries in the Budget.
