Word Limit: 500	We are looking for assistance to accomplish County requirements and augmentations to continue cultivation. The biggest of these costs are the repair of the apron on Wade Rd entry to Alder Point Rd (50' asphalt ~\$7,500) and the replacing of soft water storage with an additional rain catchment (~\$47,000) to meet the requirements and to continue with our conversion to better, more environmentally sound permaculture.

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Word Limit: 500	<p>Replacing the soft storage bladder with a pond will reduce our water diversion with rain catchment. To build the pond we will hire local contractors and rent the equipment from local businesses bringing taxable revenue to the county. We have engineered Grading Plan and Fish and Game permits already approved for this of the project, attached. The pond will help long term on many levels, including possible fire suppression and water independence from weather conditions, all strengthening the positive outcome for our cultivation business.</p> <p>The road apron repair, completed by a local contractor, will bring taxable income to the county and reduce dust and particulate from entering the road system.</p>
Word Limit 500	<p>30% of our cultivation uses a proprietary permaculture recirculating system which reduces a water usage and waste water by 40% We plan to increase this process to the rest of the farm over the next 5 years.</p>
Word Limit: 500	<p>We are mom and pop boutique cannabis farm dedicated to creating distinctive flowers bringing country wide appeal to Humboldt region while offering sustainable permaculture practices.</p>
