# SECOND AMENDMENT PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT BY AND BETWEEN COUNTY OF HUMBOLDT AND

#### BIG BROTHER AND BIG SISTERS OF THE NORTH COAST, INC FOR FISCAL YEAR 2021-2022

This "Second Amendment to the Professional Services Agreement" (the "Second Amendment") is entered into, by and between the County of Humboldt, a political subdivision of the State of California, hereinafter referred to as "COUNTY," and Big Brothers and Big Sisters of the North Coast, Inc., a California nonprofit organization, hereinafter referred to as "CONTRACTOR," on the last date signed below for the following consideration:

WHEREAS, COUNTY, by and through its Department of Health and Human Services Department – Social Services, desired to retain a qualified professional organization to implement a one-to-one youth mentorship program that is designed to reduce the need for child welfare and behavioral health intervention services in Humboldt County; and

WHEREAS, on August 9, 2021, COUNTY and CONTRACTOR (collectively, the "Parties") entered into a Professional Services Agreement (the "Agreement") regarding implementation of a one-to-one youth mentorship program in Humboldt County; and

WHEREAS, on November 16, 2021 the Parties amended the Agreement to modify the PAYMENT section of the Agreement and EXHIBIT C thereto to allow for more specific payment terms and invoicing cycles; and

WHEREAS, the Parties now desire to amend certain provisions of the Agreement and increase the overall budget.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the covenants and promises contained herein, the Parties mutually agree to further amend the Agreement as follows:

- I. Section 4 Compensation, of the Agreement is hereby amended and replaced in its entirety to read as follows:
  - A. <u>Maximum Amount Payable</u>. The maximum amount payable by COUNTY for any and all services provided, and costs and expenses incurred, pursuant to the terms and conditions of this Agreement is One Hundred One Thousand, Eight Hundred Seventy-Four Dollars (\$101,874.00). CONTRACTOR hereby agrees to perform any and all services required by this Agreement for an amount not to exceed such maximum dollar amount. However, if any applicable local, state or federal funding sources or allowance rates are reduced or eliminated, COUNTY may, by amendment, reduce the maximum amount payable hereunder or terminate this Agreement as set forth herein.
  - B. <u>Schedule of Rates</u>. The specific rates and costs applicable to this Agreement are set forth in Exhibit B Schedule of Rates, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as if set forth in full.

- C. <u>Additional Services</u>. Any additional services not otherwise set forth herein shall not be provided by CONTRACTOR, or compensated by COUNTY, without COUNTY's prior written authorization. Any and all unauthorized costs and expenses incurred above the maximum payable amount set forth herein shall be the responsibility of CONTRACTOR. CONTRACTOR shall notify COUNTY, in writing, at least six (6) weeks prior to the date upon which CONTRACTOR estimates that the maximum payable amount will be reached.
- 2. The Agreement is hereby amended to replace Exhibit B Schedule of Rates ("Exhibit B") in its entirety with the attached version of Exhibit B Schedule of Rates which is incorporated herein by reference as if set forth in full. The Parties hereby agree the attached version of Exhibit B Schedule of Rates shall supersede any and all prior versions thereof as of the effective date of this Second Amendment.
- 3. Except as expressly modified herein, the Agreement, as previously amended, shall remain in full force and effect. In the event of a conflict between the provisions of this Second Amendment and the Agreement or any prior amendments thereto, the provisions of this Second Amendment shall govern.
