It will have the lowest impact on the site and surrounding structures. We feel it will be the least disruptive to the property and community. It will be easier to implement and quickly provide the absolutely necessary protection so as not to lose the Apparatus to the North Coast elements. The attached image approximately shows a desired covered area in orange, that will simply be a shed roof attached to the side of the existing firehouse much like a porch roof over a patio. 


